## Walk-On Request Form

Thank you for your interest in skiing/snowboarding with our patrol for the day. We consider two types of walk-on requests:

#1: To actively patrol with team for the day. (Walk on request)

#2: A recruitment visit to potentially join our patrol (Recruitment visit)

### Requirements:

#### #1: Walk on Request

- Must be and active NSP Senior Patroller
- Must provide valid NSP registration, OEC, and CPR cards
- Must sign a Boyne Mountain liability release
- Must complete a full duty day (8:00am to 5:00pm), and ski with assigned team.
- Patroller attire: NSP jacket, aid belt and navy or black pants
- You will receive 1 lift ticket and 1 meal voucher

#### #2: Recruitment visit

- Sign a Boyne Mountain liability release
- Expectations are to participate in a complete duty day (8:00am-5:00pm),
- Use this time to interact with the patrol, ask lots of questions, active observation.
- You shall not wear any clothing identify as an NSP member
- You shall not interact with patients (no toboggan handling, or first aid)  You will receive 1 lift ticket and 1 meal voucher
